MPA Summer Art Camps Update

MPA is excited to announce that we will be offering both in-person and online summer camp programming. - Online Sessions: June 22-August 7, 10:30-11:30am (morning) and 1:00-2:00pm (afternoon). \$150/session
- In-Studio Sessions: July 6-August 7, 9:30am-12:00pm (morning) and 1:30-4pm (afternoon). \$195/session


MPA Summer Art Camps (Ages 6–12)

- Online Sessions: June 22-August 7, 1-hour sessions for ages 6-8, 75-minute sessions for ages 9-12. \$155/session
- In-Studio Sessions: July 6-August 7, 9am-12:00 noon (morning), 1-4pm (afternoon). Campers have the option of attending both morning and afternoon sessions. \$325/session (\$305 MCC district residents)

Teen Summer Opportunities

- Vosler Young Artists Studio: For teens ages 13–18. No previous experience necessary. August
- 10-14, 9:30am-4pm. \$460/\$435 MCC district residents
- MPA's Counselor in Training Program (CIT): Ages 13–17, 8:45am–4:15pm. \$395 for a 2-weeks program. Minimum commitment of two weeks required.




We hope you'll join us for our July 15 online opening reception from 7–8pm.


MPA ArtReach Update
