Attention all artists: MPA is currently seeking submissions for our 2024 Spring Solos. Contemporary living artists working in the Mid-Atlantic Region are invited to submit exhibition or project proposals to be on display in the Emerson and Atrium Galleries. The dates for the exhibitions will be from April 11 – June 15, 2024. **Each selected artist will receive a \$500 honorarium.**

**Opening Reception**: April 11, 2024

Artist Talk: May 19, 2024 1-3pm

**Application:** Proposals will be submitted via the online submission system Submittable. There is no fee for submission. Exhibition proposals will be reviewed by the curatorial team of the McLean Project for the Arts. All works must fit through an 81" x 64" doorway. A 30% sales commission will be retained by MPA on all sales resulting directly from the exhibit.



# Winter Art Class Spotlight: NEW Pottery Classes with Jimmy Potters!

This winter, come in from the cold and join MPA for an exciting lineup of Winter art classes for all ages, interests, and abilities. MPA's winter lineup includes some of our long-time favorites, as well as exciting new options, including:

- **NEW!** Folding Forms & Hand Building for the Garden, with Jimmy Potters --Thursdays from 11am-12:30pm, beginning January 25
- **NEW!** Pottery Around the World for ages 6-12, Thursdays from 4-5:30pm, beginning January 25

#### **Meet Jimmy Potters**

Jimmy Potters, a skilled ceramic artisan residing in Northern Virginia, embarked on his journey into the world of clay artistry through formal education at Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond, Virginia.

In addition to his own artistic endeavors, Jimmy is deeply passionate about sharing his craft with young minds. He established The Jimmy Potters Workshop, a unique mobile studio that travels to various locations, including daycares, community centers, and after-school programs.

When he's not imparting his knowledge to aspiring artists, Jimmy ventures beyond his hometown to exhibit and sell his handcrafted ceramics at art shows in different locales.

Register now for Jimmy's Folding Forms & Hand Building for the Garden (adults) and Pottery Around the World (ages 6-12) classes. Both sessions begin January 25. Young artists ages 7-12 are also invited to join us on Monday evenings from 5-6:15pm for Abrakadoodle: Sculpt It!
