Summer and Summer Art Camp season is an especially busy time at MPA for our Education & ArtReach Operations Manager, Briana Clorey.

Briana goes into Camp Director mode each summer – coordinating the recruitment and hiring of the FCPS teachers joining us as staff, coming up with themes for each week, working with camp teachers on supply orders, and preparing all of the forms and administrative materials to help ensure things run smoothly for our 300 campers and their families and everyone stays safe.



When camps kickoff, she graciously and efficiently coordinates camper drop offs at the beginning of each week, handles any camper emergency needs through each day of camp, continually checks in with camp teachers on any issues, accompanies all-day campers at lunch, and sometimes even jumps in as an extra camp teacher – like last week, when our morning campers experimented with spray art outside on the MCC grounds.

We don't know what we'd do without her, and hope if you happen to see her in our galleries or around the MCC, you say hi and thank her for the great job she does helping to make each camper's experience special!

Calling all sculptors! MPA currently seeks submissions for *Sculpture NOW* 2024, presented by Washington Sculptors Group and McLean Project for the Arts. The dates for the exhibition will be from Thursday, September 12 – Saturday, October 26, 2024. Nancy Sausser, MPA Artistic Director and Curator, will juror the show.

Sculpture NOW 2024 is a non-thematic exhibition of new works, finished within the last two years. Three-dimensional freestanding sculpture, wall-hung and ceiling-hung sculpture, and installations as well as multimedia and performance-based works are welcome.

Fall Arts Education Preview!

MPA is excited to be adding new instructors and new classes to our Fall arts education lineup. Here's a small preview of some of our NEW offerings.

New Offerings for Fall, ages 16 - Adult

NEW – Cross Currents in Contemporary Art Join MPA ArtReach Director Sharon Fishel for this off-site art appreciation class. Each session explores new ways of seeing and thinking about contemporary art in selected exhibitions at three local venues: The Phillips Collection, National Museum of Women in the Arts and IA&A at Hillyer, as well as other galleries located at Dupont Circle in D.C. There will be an optional sketchbook component for drawing or writing from the exciting works on view. Instructor: Sharon Fishel Off-site Class 3 sessions @3 hours, \$150 Fridays, 10/11-10/25

NEW – Exploring Landscapes in Pastels

Students will learn how to create believable impressionistic landscapes with soft pastel. They will learn the basics of pastel papers, colors and theories that they can employ to create paintings they would love to display or sell to others. The workshop covers aerial perspective, working with a limited palette, how to make various types of marks, paying attention to what's in light and what's in shadow, and more. NEW – Abstract Painting Series

For all levels! Knowledge of acrylics or oils is a prerequisite. Students develop abstract painting skills through the self-expression of color and form through limitations. Classic foundational concepts of composition, value and color are discussed before going into abstract style. The motifs of landscape, figure and still life are examined along with the classic compositional elements of line, balance and contrast. Students respond to color and emotion and document it in class. Instructor: Bryan Jernigan 3 lessons @2.5 hours Sundays, 11/17-12/1 2-4:30pm

NEW – Intro to Oil

Open for all levels! The class provides a foundation in observation-based painting in the style of classical realism. We will learn about value, proportions and colors and explore painting of a still life, landscape and portrait. Classes will include a combination of demonstration, step-by-step direction and discussion/art appreciation. Instructor: Stephanie Chang 6 lessons, @2.5 hours Tuesdays, 9/24-10/29 10am-12:30pm

NEW – Portrait and Figure Painting

This class provides a foundation in observation-based figure and portrait painting in the style of classical realism. We will cover the anatomy of the human face and figure and learn about gestures, value, proportions and colors. Classes will include a combination of demonstration, step-by-step directions and discussion/art appreciation. Instructor: Stephanie Chang 6 lessons@3 hours
