

Registration for MPA's 2025 Summer Art Camps is now open. MPA's weekly themed camps are a great way to discover and explore a different art medium, make new friendships, and create artworks for friends and family to enjoy. Our camps have something for everyone, from ages 6 to 18.

Offerings include MPA Art Camps (ages 6-13) and our CIT program, for students age 14-18. Sessions run June 23-August 8, 2025. Sign up early to secure your spot!

MPA Summer Art Camps (ages 6-13): Join us for a variety of imaginative and fun week-long camp sessions, all taught by experienced classroom art teachers! Each week will feature different art activities that will ignite your child's creativity. Themes include Art Across the World (*NEW!*), Mask-querade!, Comic Books, Hand Building with Clay, and more.

Sessions run from 9am-12pm (morning session) and 1-4pm (afternoon session). Campers have the option of attending both sessions for a full-day experience. All materials are provided. Camps will be held in our studios at the McLean Community Center. Tuition \$295 per session/\$280 MCC district residents

Teen Summer Opportunities (ages 14-18): Older students are invited to join MPA for our Counselor in Training Program (CIT). MPA's CIT Program was developed to enrich the experience of older campers at our summer artcamps, through encouraging teaching and leadership skills. MPA ArtReach Deepens Community Partnerships

MPA ArtReach is enjoying visits from community partners to our two current gallery exhibitions—*Pieced Together, We are Whole* and *Playing With Shadows: Works by Liz Lescault.*

With the McLean SPARC Solutions group currently meeting in the McLean Community Center while the Old Firehouse is undergoing renovation, it's provided the opportunity to set up a schedule of bi-weekly time with their group — both for in-gallery visits to see our exhibitions, and for related workshops to create their own works of art.

During this week's workshop, ArtReach Director Sharon Fishel worked with the group and their helpers to create collage projects in the style of the quilt works they saw last week on a gallery tour of "Pieced Together: We are Whole."

The project allowed group members with limited functional movement capability to select and place pieces of their collage, as illustrated in the photos. MPA's Curator and Director of Exhibitions Nancy Sausser commented that "piecing is an important part of the process," and was pleased to see how the group's work connected to the artwork they had visited earlier.

Special thanks to SPARC Solutions staff member Elissa Juskalian for helping to make these regular visits possible! And thanks as well to some of our other ongoing community partners —including weekly visits with the Wellness Center for Older Adults in Fairfax, (both for weekly classes with themes relating to natural sources and art history, as well as occasional gallery visits); and ongoing in-classroom art activity visits with the McLean High School Special Ed program and Longfellow Middle School art department; and continuing virtual classes with ServiceSource groups, averaging an exciting 40-60 participants each week!
